

EMERGENCY PREPARATIONS

MAKE SURE YOU HAVE DEFENSIBLE SPACE AROUND YOUR HOME & OTHER STRUCTURES.

1. **KEEP A TWO-WAY RADIO OR RADIOS WITH FULLY-CHARGED BATTERIES.**
 1. Pre-set radio(s) to 9 – 11 or be sure you know how to do it.
 2. Do not talk on 9-11 unless it is an emergency or potential threat.
 3. A pair of two-way radios and a scanner will be located in the clubhouse for emergency use only.

1. **KNOW WHERE YOUR FLYING-O RANCH EMERGENCY PACKET IS AND HOW TO USE IT.**
2. **KEEP IMPORTANT PAPERS, PHOTOS, ETC. BOXED AND READY TO GO,** include medications you might need.

- Know what is most important to you and where it is in case you have to leave quickly. Consider splitting up pictures and negatives, extra CDs, etc. and storing in another location (off the ranch).

1. **HAVE CARRYING CASES FOR PETS.**
2. **ALL FAMILY MEMBERS SHOULD HAVE CPR.**
